The Scholarship Program is open to any young person who is a parish member, attends church weekly and is a senior in high school. The scholarship award must be used for post-high school academic or vocational programs. The award amount is \$500 (or more) each to one young man and one young woman. The scholarship will be awarded on a merit basis and the candidate must have:

#### A GPA of 3.0 or higher

- > Service activities
- Extra-curricular activities and/or an after-school job

For the application process you must complete the following:

- o Complete the attached form
- o Submit a written essay of 300 words or less on one of the topics listed on page 5
- o Attach 2 letters of recommendation. At least one must be from an adult not connected to your school
- o A copy of last year's report card and a current report card

The entire packet should be dropped off at the back of the church in the marked basket by 11:30 am, Sunday, April 28, 2024.

The above criteria will be used to select the semi-finalists. An interview team from the Knights will interview the young men and the Sisterhood will interview the young women. All materials and interviews will be kept in confidentiality by the scholarship committees. The awards will be presented at the 10:30 am Mass on Sunday, June 9, 2024.
