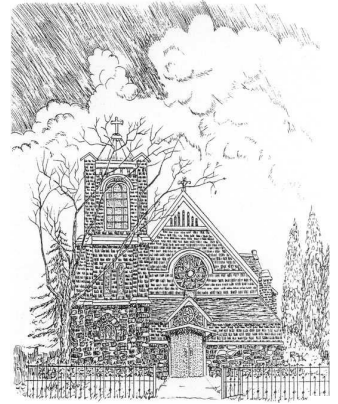

## Fifth Sunday of Lent, Cycle B

Sunday, March 17, 2024

John 12:20-33

Jesus teaches his disciples about the way in which he will be glorified by God, and a voice from heaven is heard to affirm this teaching.

Today's Gospel reading is taken from the Gospel of John. We are reading much further into John's Gospel than we have for the past two weeks. Chapter 12 of John's Gospel is a preparation for the beginning of the passion narrative to follow. Jesus has just raised Lazarus from the dead, an important sign in John's Gospel, which inspired many people to believe in Jesus. This event also marks the turning point in Jesus' conflict with the Jewish authorities. John's Gospel tells us that the Sanhedrin met after this event and made plans to kill Jesus. In the 12th chapter of John's Gospel, Jesus is anointed at Bethany and enters Jerusalem in triumph. We again see evidence of the significance of the raising of Lazarus to this event; John reports that the crowds also gathered to see Lazarus.

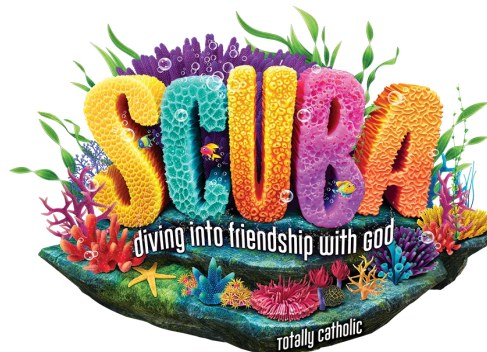

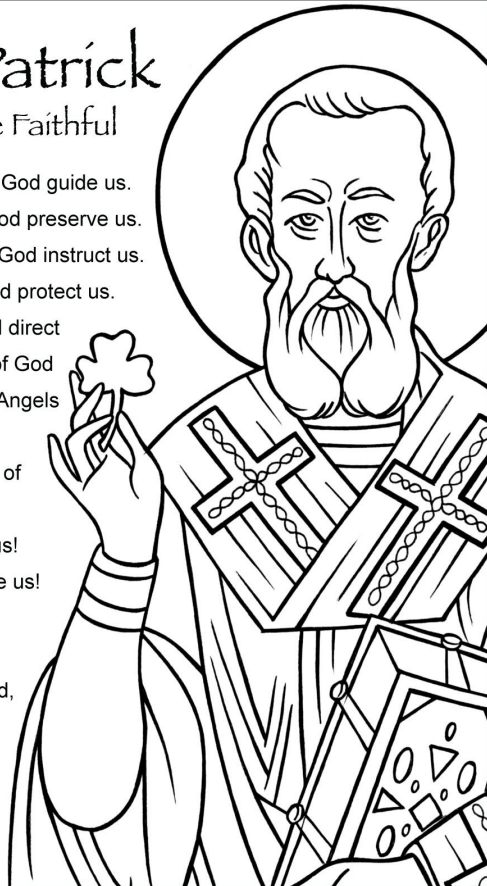

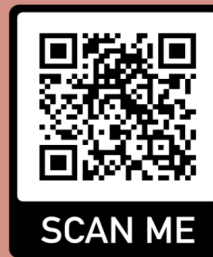

## Fulfilling Your DSA Pledge with a Qualified Charitable Distribution from Your IRA

Thank you for your support of the Diocesan Services Appeal! With an IRA charitable rollover gift, you can support the work of the Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lansing and enjoy valuable tax benefits by making a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) to The Catholic Foundation. Even better, your gift may count toward your required minimum distribution for the year. If you make a QCD, you will not have to pay federal income tax on the amount of your rollover gift.

### Requirements/Limitations

- Donors must be age 70 ½ or older on the date of the gift
- Up to \$100,000 may be given annually.
- Only funds in traditional and Roth IRAs are eligible. QCDs are not allowed from inherited IRAs, 401(k)s, 403(b)s, or other qualified retirement plans. However, some people may be able to roll assets from such a plan into a traditional IRA and then make QCD.
